The W. T. STEARN PRIZE

is awarded to the best original, unpublished essay in the field of the history of natural history. The competition is open to undergraduate and postgraduate students in full or parttime education, or within two years of completion.

The winner receives £300 and one year's free membership of the Society for the History of Natural History (SHNH).

The winning essay will normally be published in the Society's prestigious journal *Archives of Natural History*.

Submissions are welcome between 1 February and 31 July 2025.*
